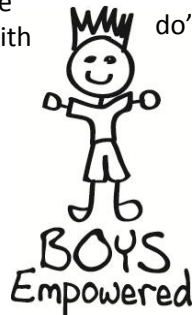

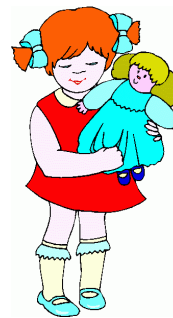
American Girl Camp (Girls ages 6-10)
